**Eucharistic
Revival**

The Eucharistic Revival and Pilgrimage currently taking place in the United States is a powerful testament to the faith and devotion of Catholics across the country. Pilgrims from all walks of life are converging in Indianapolis, Indiana, to participate in this spiritual journey, which is centered around the belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

What sets this pilgrimage apart is the unique route that the pilgrims are taking to reach their destination. Four routes, which form the shape of a crucifix, are being used by the participants to travel to Indianapolis. Each route has its own theme and significance, with one of the routes being the North Marian Route.

The Marian Route is particularly special as it allows pilgrims to honor the Mother of God and seek her intercession as they journey towards Indianapolis passing through Chicagoland, and **close to us between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM on June 30th in Bellwood, Illinois at Mar Thoma Sleeha Cathedral, 5000 St. Charles Road.**

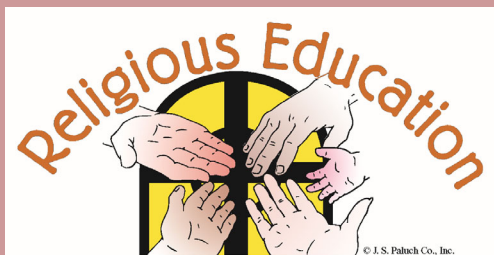

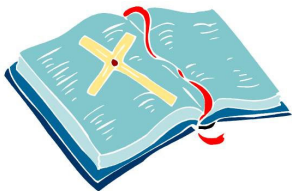

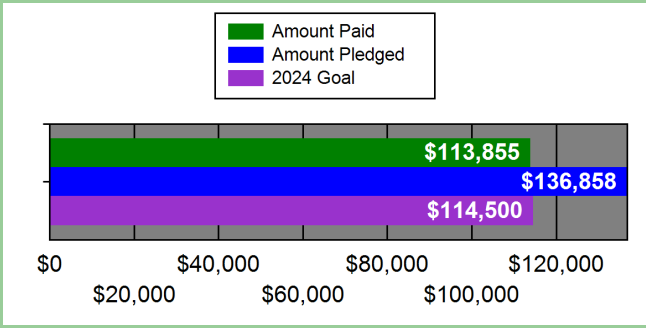
